# Peter Gilgan Leadership Award -Selection Committee Member

**Nature and Scope:** The Peter Gilgan Leadership Award bursary program is funded through the generosity of the Peter Gilgan Foundation. Peter Gilgan is the founder and CEO of Mattamy Homes, a generous YMCA supporter, community builder and philanthropist. The Peter Gilgan Leadership Award is designed to provide financial assistance to employees at the YMCA of Oakville who are pursuing post-secondary studies. The intent is to invest in the academic development of youth employees who demonstrate leadership potential and have made notable contributions to the YMCA and community. Five awards of up to \$4,000 each will be granted annually to selected recipients. The bursary program is administered by the YMCA of Oakville in conjunction with the Peter Gilgan Foundation. Applicants will be screened based on their eligibility and referred to a selection committee for consideration.
